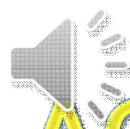

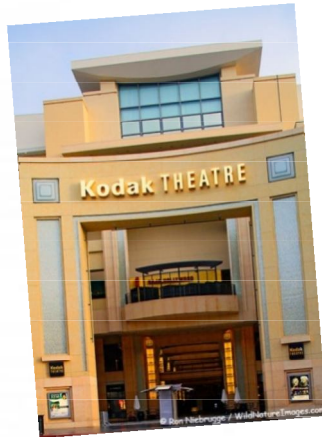


**Overall,
the Oscar award ceremony**


- The first ceremony was in 1929 at the Hollywood Roosevelt Hotel but attracted moderate interest, and lasted only 15 minutes.
- To increase the popularity awards contributed to the media, radio, and television.
- For any of the nominees did not get any earlier than about winning ceremony used sealed envelopes containing the names of the winners.



- Usually held on the last Sunday of February.
- It is run by celebrities.
- Since 2002, the awards are given in the Kodak Theatre in Hollywood.



- Its main purpose is to reward outstanding people falling film in 24 categories.



It is a worldwide award
and everyone regardless of their origin can get it.
However, throughout the history of the ceremony

only 7 black actors
really deserve it.

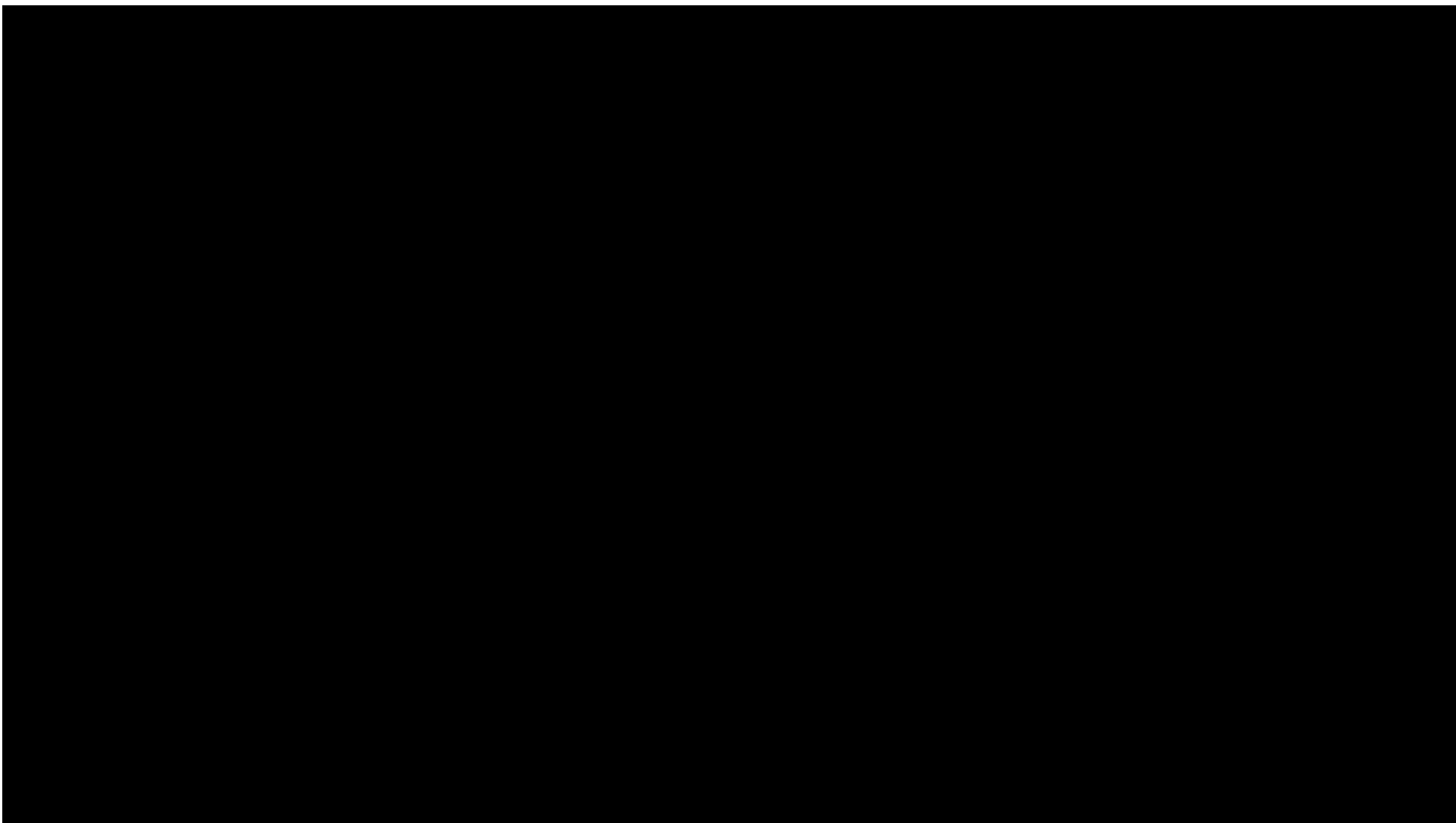

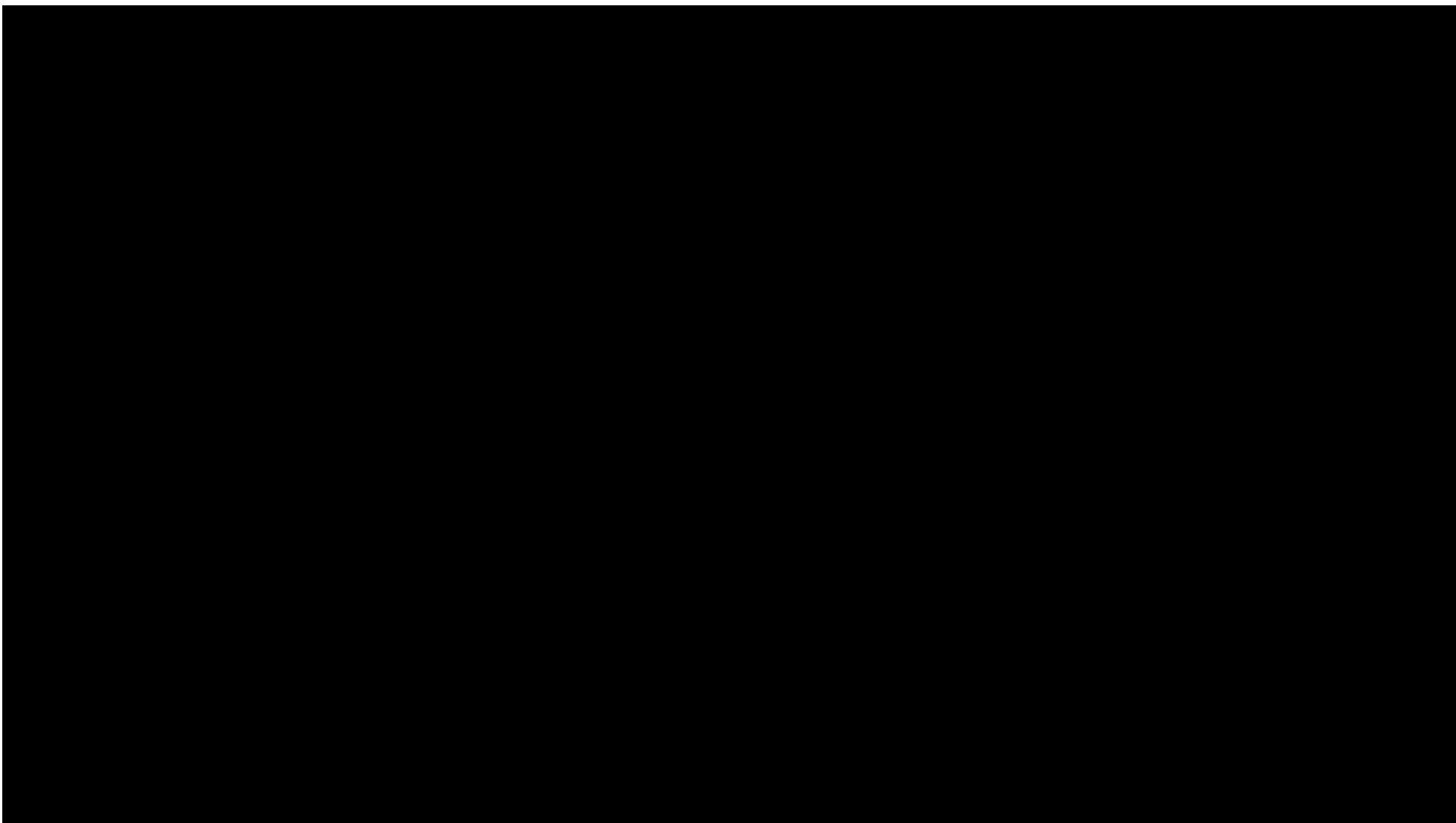
